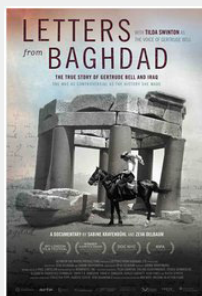

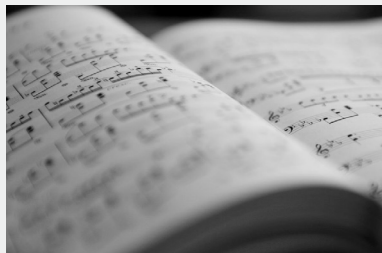

## Pastoral Network Scheme

---

Events of the past two weeks have shown us how important it is that we care for each other, as a community. The pastoral network scheme was launched in June 2010 and membership is open to anyone who lives in the parish.

The pastoral groups are arranged geographically, with neighbouring roads grouped together. Each group has a Link Person and a Co-Link, who keep 'a friendly eye out' for the members of the group.

If someone has not been seen for four weeks, the Link Person makes contact to check if all is okay – by e-mail, phone or visit, whatever seems appropriate for that person. If there are concerns, the Link Person contacts one of the Pastoral Assistants.

We are raising the profile of this scheme, and there is a list of existing members and their groups on the noticeboard at the back of the church. If your name is not there and you wish to be included, please add your name to the sheet and you will be added to a group.
